Rug-making

Named after: *TRIBE/FAMILY/MAKER and PLACE/ORIGIN **[1]**
*must be in this order

Quality of wool: best is SOFT/SMOOTH/SHINY
cheaper is COARSE(R)/ROUGH(ER) **[1]**

Persian or Turkish knots can be used and show that rug is HANDMADE but loops mean MACHINE-MADE. **[1]**

Colour production: warm red PLANT dye, but crimson means chineal, an insect dye. **[1]**

Rug-maker: leaves DATE and SIGNATURE on rug **[1]**

Sign of a great rug: has PATTERN on reverse as well as front **[1]**
